Proper Installation is Critical to Initial and Long Term Success of a Green Roof

The following statements must be certified and signed by the job site foreman who conducted the installation before a warranty may be issued.

	Job Site Foreman has reviewed LiveRoof- supplied installation training materials and/or been trained by a LiveRoof representative, has remained on site, and has ensured consistent adherence to the LiveRoof Standardized Procedures.
	☐ The slip sheet used meets specifications of LiveRoof, membrane manufacturer and architect.
	☐ All aggregate or debris was swept off of the slip sheet before placing each module.
	☐ Each module was properly placed and visually inspected for corners that align with the corners of neighboring modules and edges that overlap edges of neighboring modules.
	☐ All Soil Elevators [™] have been completely pulled out, from the front side whenever possible, and every effort was made to avoiding walking on the plant material when removing soil elevators.
	Every effort was made to NOT WALK ON THE PLANT MATERIAL during the installation. Incidental, one time/one person, foot traffic being the exception.
	☐ The LiveRoof® Operation Manual has been given to the person(s) responsible for maintenance (as indicated on page 3).
	RoofEdge® or other edging has been properly installed as needed: O Between the modules and stone ballast O Wherever parapet or paver is of insufficient height/thickness to contain the soil.
	☐ The edging used is perforated at the bottom to allow water to drain freely.

Preventative Maintenance is Critical to the Long Term Success of a Green Roof System.

For this reason, LiveRoof Global LLC requires maintenance training in order to issue a warranty. The following statements must be certified and signed by the building owner, LiveRoof representative, and, if maintenance is contracted to a third party, the hired maintenance contractor.

The undersigned:

- Have been trained in the LiveRoof maintenance protocol.
- Understand that weeding twice per month breaks the life cycle of a weed, preventing it from flowering and setting seed, and thus minimizing the ongoing effort required to keep the roof weed-free.
- Understand that walking on the plants more than once per week may cause damage.
- Understand that chemical and salt deicers may kill plantings and should not be used on or adjacent to plantings.

- Understand that a field soil fertility test should be conducted each spring and the roof should be fertilized with a <u>controlled release</u> fertilizer according to the test recommendations.
- Understand that green roofs may require water during periods of hot, dry weather.
- Understand that watering the green roof more than the proscribed amount may lead to overly wet conditions and cause plant disease and rot.
- Agrees to provide email address to receive monthly reminders from LiveRoof Global LLC which include seasonal care instructions for the green roof system.

The plants are intended to be of an assortment that is hardy, durable, long-lived and sustainable for your local climate (as advised by your experienced local, licensed LiveRoof® grower). Any arrangement for vegetation with a lesser degree of coverage or plant material other than plants recommended by experienced professional growers may result in suboptimal performance, increased maintenance, and is at the discretion of the system owner.

Similarly, the LiveRoof® system is intended to be supplied with LiveRoof® engineered soil, in accord with established LiveRoof® and German FLL soil specifications. Any deviation from such specifications may result in suboptimal performance; resultant performance is solely at the discretion and responsibility of the system owner.
